Stove Sensor

Monitors electric and induction stoves in real time, alerting caregivers if the stove is left on too long or unattended so individuals can cook independently while staying safe.

Chair/Bed Pressure Pad Sensor

Detects when someone gets up from a bed or chair during overnight hours and immediately alerts on-site or Remote Support staff, supporting fall prevention without the need for cameras.



Door/Window Sensor

Instantly detects when any door or window opens or closes, enabling caregivers to monitor arrivals, departures, and nighttime movement discreetly and reliably.

Flood Sensor

Detects water on the floor in bathrooms and kitchens and sends an immediate alert to caregivers, preventing unnoticed leaks or overflows from becoming serious hazards.



Motion Sensor

Tracks movement in key areas of the home to flag unusual activity, support wandering monitoring, and build a picture of daily routines without cameras.



Smoke Alarm Monitor

Listens for an existing smoke alarm and immediately notifies caregivers via text, email, or phone, ensuring the right people are alerted even if the individual cannot call for help.

Range Extender

Strengthens the Z-Wave network across larger homes or multi-floor settings, ensuring every sensor stays reliably connected and every alert gets through.



Z-Wave Smart Plug

Turns any standard outlet into a monitored, remotely controlled connection point, allowing caregivers to cut power to appliances left on, set usage schedules, and receive alerts automatically.

Button Sensor

Gives individuals a simple one-press way to call for help at any time, triggering immediate alerts to caregivers, on-site staff, or the 24/7 Remote Support team.
